


Sanma is the second most populous province in Vanuatu with almost 46,000 residents. It is home to Luganville, the only urban centre outside of the nation's capital, Port Vila.

Luganville, on Santo island, is a city of just over 13,000 people. In fact, the majority of Sanma's population reside on Santo island - it is home to almost 40,000 people.


Sanma has higher proportion of people aged 20-24

Population by sex and age, Sanma 2009




Luganville (urban) population

Rural Sanma population




Women marry younger than men

Mean age at first marriage by sex and province, Vanuatu, 2009




Much greater proportion of older women are widowed

Marital status of widowed by age and sex, Sanma 2009




Men's health at risk through smoking

Smoking prevalence by sex and urban/rural, ages 15+, Sanma, 2009




Alcohol consumption highest amongst urban men

Employment in different occupations, by sex, Vanuatu 2009






Proportion of the population that has never been to school, by age and sex



Higher proportion of people not in school in Rural Sanma




Adults aged 15+ with secondary school as highest level of education,

Prevalence of disability by severity, province and sex, Vanuatu 2009


