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
PREFACE

OVERVIEW

Cattle Production (refer to Table 1.)

- The total number of cattle heads slaughtered in March quarter 2019 stood at 2,356. This is a decline of 1% over corresponding period in 2018 and also decrease by 5% over the previous quarter.


Copra exports (refer to tables 6.2 and 6.3)

- In March quarter 2019, the quantity of copra exports increase by 22% or 63 tonnes over the March quarter 2018 but dropped from 108 tonnes from 462 tonnes to 354 tonnes in the previous quarter.
- In value terms, copra exports decreased by 15% or VT 3 million over March quarter 2018 and also decrease of 33% over the previous quarter.
- Copra export receipts constituted a 2% share of the total domestic exports in value for March quarter 2019.
- The average export price of copra on year to year quarter fell by 30% and 13% over the previous quarter.

Coconut Oil (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- The quantity of Coconut oil exports for March quarter 2019 fell by 37% or 389 tonnes compared to 1,061 tonnes to 672 tonnes in March quarter of 2018. However, it showed a slight increase of 22% over the previous quarter.

- In Value terms, coconut oil exports decreased by 53% or VT 69 million in March quarter 2019 over March quarter 2018..


- The average export price of coconut oil decreased by 27% in the March quarter 2019, over the same quarter of the previous year and 5% over December quarter of 2018.

- Coconut oil receipts constituted a 5% share of total domestic export value in March quarter 2019.

March quarter 2017 to March quarter 2019




Cocoa Exports (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- In March quarter 2019, the quantity of cocoa exports increased by 84% or 76 tonnes over the March quarter of 2018 and 31% over December quarter 2018.
- In value terms, cocoa exports increased by VT 17 million over the same quarter of 2018.
- Cocoa exports receipts constituted a 2% share of the total domestic exports value in March quarter 2019.

March quarter 2017 to March quarter 2019




Beef (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- Beef exports decreased by 10% in March quarter 2019 to 27 tonnes from 30 tonnes in March quarter 2018. However, it increased by 81% over the previous quarter.
- In value terms, beef exports increased by 8% or VT 1 million over March quarter 2018.
- The average beef export price increased by 20% over the March quarter 2018.
- Beef export value constituted a 1% share of the total domestic export receipts in March quarter 2019.

Kava (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- Kava exports in quantity increased by 6% or 10 tonnes in March quarter of 2019 over March quarter 2018 and 1% over December quarter in 2018.


- In Value terms, kava exports stood at VT 724 million in March quarter 2019, representing an increase of 8% or VT 55 million over the March quarter of 2018.

- Kava exports constituted a 60% share of the total domestic export receipts in March quarter 2019.
- The implied average kava export price increased by 2% over March quarter of 2018.

March quarter 2017 to March quarter 2019




Domestic Exports (refer to Tables 6.1 and 6.5)

- In March quarter 2019, provisional figures, in domestic export (excluding re-exports) earnings increased by 1% or VT 10 million. The increase was attributed to increases in exports for cocoa at VT 17 million vatu, followed by coffee 53%, other products at 17% and kava and beef at 8% respectively, over March quarter 2018.

- The share of commodities to main countries of export destination include the following; Other MSG Countries at 20%, European community at 12%, Australia at 7%, New Caledonia at 3%, New Zealand at 2%, Japan and South Korea at 1% each respectively. Other countries accounted for 55% share of main exports destination. The top five countries which made up other countries comprised of Malaysia, Kiribati, United States of America, Philippines and China.


Trade Deficit (refer to Table 6.1)

- Vanuatu's trade deficit stood at VT 6,287 million for March quarter 2019. It shows a decrease of 14% or VT 1,003 million, thus showing an improvement driven by the decrease in total imports of 16% compared to March quarter 2018.

March quarter 2017 to March quarter 2019




Imports for Home Consumption (refer to Tables 6.6 and 6.8)

- Imports for home consumption decreased in value by 14% or VT 1,268 million from VT 8,767 million in March quarter 2018 to VT 7,499 million in March quarter of 2019.
- The imported commodity groups that contributed to this decrease were: Crude materials at (-90%), goods not classified elsewhere at (-29%), machines and transport at (-19%), beverages and tobacco at (-17%), oils and fats at (-10%), miscellaneous manufactured goods at (-7%), and chemical products at (-1%).
- In contrast the rest of the imported items that increased include; Mineral fuels at 29%, basic manufactured goods at 9% and food and live animals at 5%.
- In terms of share of commodity groups to total imports receipts, machines and transport made up the largest value (C.I.F) of VT 1,695 million or 23% of the total imports for home consumption, followed by food and live animals at 21%, mineral fuels at 17%, basic manufactured products at 16%, miscellaneous manufactured goods at 10%, chemical products at 7%, beverages and tobacco at 3%, crude materials and goods not classified elsewhere at 2% each of the total imports for home consumption.
- The total value of the selected ten major imported items increased by 2% or VT 26 million from VT 1,557 million in corresponding quarter of 2017 to VT 1,583 million in March quarter 2019.
- The commodities that increased were: Cigarettes and Tobacco at 67% or VT 29 million followed by motor spirit at 64%, cement at 34%, distillate fuels at 30%, wheat flour at 19%, However, the commodities which decreased were: Jet fuel at (56%) or VT 121 million, rice at (38%), pharmaceutical products at 11% of the total value of the selected ten major imported items over the March quarter of 2018.
- In terms of the share of the selected ten major imports receipts; Distillate fuels recorded the largest share at 48%, followed by rice at 14%, motor spirit at 9%, pharmaceutical products at 7%, cement, jet fuel and wheat flour at 6% each and cigarettes and tobacco at 5%.

December quarter 2016 to December quarter 2018




Tourism (refer to Tables 7.1 to 7.4)

- The total international visitor arrivals to Vanuatu for March quarter 2019 stood at 58,935. This is a decline of 47% over corresponding period in 2018 and also decline by 28% over the previous quarter. The decline of visitor arrivals over corresponding period were attributed by the fall in number of visitor arrivals by both air and sea.

March quarter 2017 to March quarter 2019




- The seasonally adjusted visitor arrivals represent a fall for both visitors by air and day visitors alike for March quarter 2019.
- Visitors by air made up 38% of all international visitors to Vanuatu. This stood at 22,409, indicating a decline of 5% over corresponding quarter in 2018 and 25% over December quarter 2018.
- Australian visitors represented 53% of all air visitors in March quarter 2019.

- Countries that recorded an increase over corresponding quarter of 2018 include; New Zealand at 10%; Australia and Japan at 2% each.

- Holiday visitors accounted for 78% of air visitors; followed by visiting friends and relatives and business, meetings or conferences at 8% each; other purposes at 6% and visitors on transit at less than 1%.
- Day visitors made up 62% of all international visitors to Vanuatu. Total day visitors stood at 36,526, a fall of 58% over March quarter 2018 and also fell by 29% over December quarter 2018. The decline over corresponding quarter was attributed by a drop in cruise ship visits to Vanuatu.

March quarter 2017 to March quarter 2019




Consumer Price Index (refer to Tables 4.1 and 4.2)

- The Consumer Price Index (CPI) of March quarter 2019 indicated an increase of (+0.9%). Port Vila slightly increased by (+1.1%) and Luganville by (+0.3%) compared to the previous quarter. When compared to the March quarter of 2018, the Vanuatu index increased by (+2.1%), Port Vila index increased by (+2.4%) while Luganville index slightly increased by (+0.8%).

- At the national level, the expenditure groups that contributed to the increase over the same quarter of last year were: Food (+3.8%), Miscellaneous (+2.2%), Transport (+2.1%), Housing Utilities (+1.6%), Clothing and Footwear and Recreation stood at (+0.7%) each, Drinks and Tobacco and Household Suppliers at (0.6%) each and Education at (+0.4%). The increase in these expenditure groups were driven by the increase in price movements of Root crops, Fruits and Vegetables, toiletries and other personal care products and other household fuel. However, Health and Communication remained constant.


Summary of Government Revenue and Expenditure

Total Government Operation (TGO) (refer to Table 5.1)*

- The total government revenue for March quarter 2019 totalled VT 9,295 million of which 86% was recurrent revenue while 14% of which were grants received from abroad. The total revenue declined by 1.9% over corresponding period in 2018 and also fell by 8.8% over previous quarter.
- The total government expenditure for March quarter increased by 12% over corresponding period in 2018 and also increased by 14% over previous quarter in 2018.

March 2017 to March 2019





Government Revenue (refer to Table 5.1)

- The total government revenue excluding donors for March quarter 2019 totalled VT 8,028 million, this is an increase of 7% over corresponding period in 2018 but fell by 15% over the previous quarter in 2018. The total tax revenue stood at VT 4,916 million, this is an increase of 2.5% over corresponding period in 2018 and also an increase of 5.1% over the previous quarter.

Government Expenditure (refer to Table 5.1)

- The total government expenditure for March quarter 2019 stood at VT 6,891 million, this is an increase of 12% compared to March quarter in 2018 and also an increase of 14% over the previous quarter.


* Government Finance Statistics (GFS) have migrated from GFS86 format to GFS01 format. This is in line with the implementation of 2001 GFS manual.

- Compensation of employees made up 42% or VT 2,892 million of total government expenditure in March quarter 2019. This is an increase of 18% compared to March quarter in 2018 but fell by 22% over the previous quarter.



- The total number of new private motor vehicle registrations in Port Vila and Luganville stood at 78. This is a decline of 83% over corresponding period in 2018 and also by 75% over previous quarter in 2018.

March quarter 2017 to March quarter 2019




Energy Consumption (refer to Table 3)

- The total energy consumed (expressed in Kilowatts) for March quarter 2019 totalled 21,137. This increased by 14% over corresponding period in 2018 and also increased by 44% over the previous quarter in 2018. This increase was attributed by the increase in electricity consumption for Malekula at 47%, Tanna at 46%, Luganville at 15% and Port Vila at 13% compared to March 2018.
