CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

Annual Growth Rate:

- Changes in Population annually, this is often expressed as percentage.

Dependency Ratio:

- It is the ratio of the people in the dependency age group (below age 15 and 60 years and above) on the "working age group" (referring to those aged 15 to 59).

Sex Ratio:

- Ratio of males to every female in a given population, expressed as the number of males per 100 females.

Population Density:

- The average number of persons per square kilometer. It is calculated by dividing the total population over land area (Km²).

Household (Private):

- A household is defined as "Those persons who usually eat together and share the work of preparing the food and/or the cost of work of providing it". A household can also be an individual person without combining with other persons.

Average Household Size:

- An average measure obtained by dividing the number of persons in the households by the total number of households in the area.
